

The Fireside Series Cabin

Our Fireside Series Cabin is the perfect blend between our singlestory Trapper Series Cabin and our two story Northwoods Series Cabin. This ranch style cabin features a double crows next dormer, adding storage space or extra sleep space. With an open floor plan, you can create your dream living environment.



General Cabin Information:

- From the ground up, these cabins are built with quality and craftsmanship. Starting with the 4"x6" treated floor joists, we add a layer of exterior grade plywood, a layer of rigid foam, a layer of interior grade plywood, then finish with the tongue and groove flooring.
- Our walls are 100% solid Eastern White Pine logs, which we source locally. There are 16 courses of logs comprising the walls of the cabin.
- We set our 3"x5" exposed timber rafters and ridge beam on the walls and top those with 1"x8" tongue and groove pine to add that beautiful wood cathedral ceiling. Finally, we add rigid foam insulation and top it with a 40 year metal roof.
- We have two building options available: Primitive or Full Amenities
 - The Primitive Cabin is a finished cabin with windows and doors installed, but does not include interior walls, electric, and plumbing.
 - The Full Amenities Cabin boasts a completely finished exterior and interior that's "move in" ready.

Additional Information:

- Foundation We can work with many foundation options including a full basement, a crawl space, a concrete slab, or a post/pier foundation. We do not recommend the cabins be placed on the ground; at minimum, a gravel pad is necessary.
- **Zoning** It is the owner's responsibility to determine the zoning requirements of their location and to secure any required permits.
- Site Accessibility & Visits You'll want to consider the height and size of your cabin upon delivery and ensure your site is accessible for the truck and trailer. Within reasonable travel distances, we can arrange to visit your site for additional consultation.
- Set Up Once onsite, it takes approximately eight (8) hours to set up and prepare your cabin for you, depending on conditions. You or your local contractor can then make any necessary utility connections.
- **Maintenance** We recommend annual application of bug deterrent and visual inspection of your cabin. Depending on your cabin's location, you will want to consider resealing the exterior every 3 to 5 years if the cabin is in a sunny location or every 5 to 8 years if the cabin is in a shaded location.

We currently offer the Fireside Cabin in a 16x32 size only.
