

- OUR QUALITY-


Quality is the heartwood of everything we do.



Our pavilions are rated to withstand at minimum a snow load of 30 PSI and winds of up to 130 mph. Turnaround time is typically 8 to 10 weeks once your order is placed. For details about how your kit will be delivered and what is included, please refer to the DELIVERY section on page 6 of this catalog. A file containing detailed installation instructions will be provided via email.

-STANDARD SIZES-

We offer our Timber Frame Pavilion Kits in the following standard sizes. Looking for a size that isn't listed here? No problem! We're happy to chat about custom sizing.

Measured by the roof line with 12" overhangs. The first number indicates the width of the gable or "slanted" side.

INCREASED POST HEIGHT

Depending on the size of your structure, we can increase the height of the posts from our standard 8-foot height up to 10 feet, 12 feet or more. (Heavy Timber pavilion with 12' posts pictured).




ADJUSTED ROOF PITCH

Looking for a different slope to the roof? In addition to the standard pitches outlined in the TIMBER FRAME PAVILIONS section on page 2 of this catalog, we can increase pitch up to 12/12 or reduce it to as low as 4/12. (Photo is for concept purposes only).

-SIMPSON HARDWARE-

Want to make your pavilion all your own? With Outdoor Accents decorative hardware from Simpson Strong-Tie, you can bring both elegance and structural strength to to your Timber Frame Pavilion. The black powder-coat finish provides protection against the elements while creating an eye-catching appearance. Our standard pavilions include Mission-style post bases. Pavilions with a gable width greater than 20' also include Mission-style gable plates and flat straps. Additional hardware and Avant-style upgrades available upon request.





-MAINTENANCE-



Our Timber Frame Pavilions are supplied as untreated Eastern White Pine. This gives you the freedom to use the stain or sealant best suited to your unique climate and tastes.

Keeping your new Timber Frame Pavilion standing strong for years to come is easy. We recommend taking the following steps to protect and maintain your structure.

- Apply a <u>water-based stain or sealant</u> to protect against the elements while allowing the wood to breath.
- If you live in an area where boring insects such as carpenter bees pose a threat, we recommend adding a borate additive* to the stain or sealant.
- Ortho Home Defense* can be applied in the spring to ward off any unwelcome guests, such as spiders and wasps.
- Periodically <u>remove buildup of debris</u> around the post bases to keep the powder-coated metal free from unwanted dirt and moisture.
- "Checking" is a normal occurrence in large timbers. If you notice any large cracks, don't worry. The cracks can be filled with caulk or simply coated with sealent to keep moisture out. Checks generally do not affect the stability and integrity of the structure, and we think they add to the rustic charm!
- If left untreated, the wood is likely to weather and turn grey. In such cases, we recommend using a product called RMR86* to clean the surface of the wood.

*Follow manufacturer's instructions.

-DOS & DON'TS-



• OBTAIN PERMITS

Zoning regulations vary widely from city to city. For this reason, we leave it up to the customer to obtain all necessary permits from their local building or zoning department.

• TALK TO YOUR HOA

Check with your Homeowners Association before placing your order.

• PREPARE THE SITE

Be sure the site is ready before delivery day. Make sure the driver has access, you're prepared to unload the kit, your cement footers or foundation are set, etc.

• STAIN OR SEAL


Refer to the MAINTENANCE section above for details.

• STORE PROPERLY

If you plan to store your kit for any period of time, use spacers between the timbers and keep it in a well-ventilated area with good air flow to prevent warping or mold due to moisture buildup. We recommend using a fan if possible.

• TELL ALL YOUR FRIENDS!

• WAIT UNTIL THE LAST MINUTE

Be sure to apply for any permits or speak with your HOA well ahead of time in case of any delays.

• USE OIL-BASED SEALANT

Our pavilions are milled from locally-sourced green timbers, which allows the natural drying process to take place. We've found that this method creates less waste and makes for a higher quality finished product. Heavy oil-based stains or sealants prevent moisture from escaping, which could lead to interior rot or warping over time.

• BE AFRAID OF CHECKING

"Checking" refers to the natural process of cracks forming as the wood dries. This is perfectly normal and generally does not affect the structural integrity of the pavilion. You can leave the checks visible to add to the rustic charm, or they can be filled with caulk. Just be sure to apply a breathable stain or sealant to prevent moisture from seeping into the cracks.

BUILD ON A WEAK FOUNDATION

Our pavilions are designed to be mounted on a concrete pad or footers. If you plan to mount your pavilion on a deck, have your contractor make sure there is sufficient support where the posts will be mounted.



-DELIVERY & INSTALLATION-



What to expect on the big day.

Once we receive the downpayment on your pavilion order, your kit will typically ship in 8-10 weeks. Actual turnaround times may vary. Our Timber Frame Pavilion Kits are normally delivered on a "Hot Shot" truck and trailer. Please ensure that the driver has access to an area where you can unload your kit. You will be responsible for unloading your kit upon delivery. This can be done using a forklift, tow motor or by hand with a few friends.

When your kit arrives, the posts will be cut on one end and left long so they can be adjusted to obtain a level beam height, which is crucial for tight joints. Beams and rafters will be precut, including notches. Tongue & groove roof boards will need trimmed after installation. Fly rafters and fascia will also need trimmed to size. Metal roofing will be cut to length; the trim metal will need cut to fit. All fasteners for the beams, rafters and metal roofing are included. You will need to anchor the post bases to the pad or footer using approved fasteners; fasteners are not included. Nails and/or screws used for attaching roof boards and wood trim are not included in the kit. All wood is Eastern White Pine and is untreated. We recommend staining or finishing for best results. These kits require some carpentry experience and are easiest to install with 3 people. Detailed installation instruction will be provided via email. They are great for contractors, landscape firms, commercial settings, and handy homeowners.

We work with contractors and dealers throughout the US that can help you install your new pavilion, while our main office offers installation services in the greater Northeast Ohio area. Of course you're always welcome to have your Timber Frame Pavilion Kit installed by a contractor of your choice! Most kits can be put up in one day. Keep in mind that contractors in different areas charge different prices, and weather may affect their work.


THE FIRESIDE SERIES
